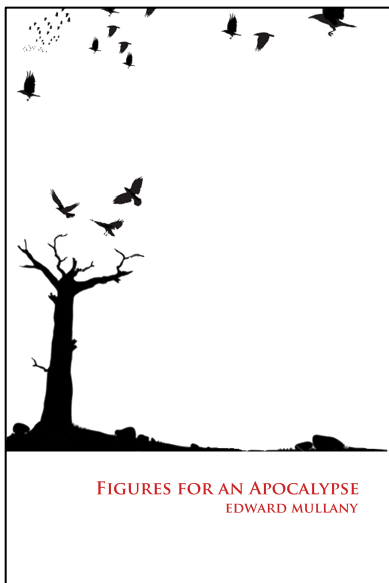

Publishing Genius was founded in Baltimore in 2006, and has released books by Rachel B. Glaser, Stephanie Barber, Michael Kimball, Shane Jones and many more. The press has been featured in *Publishers Weekly*, *Poets and Writers* and several other industry magazines.
